Modern liberalism, then, is what you might call a "subideology" within classical liberalism. Modern liberals believe, for example, that government should be limited, but that it should be more limited with regard to laws about people's personal lives (gay rights, abortion) than with regard to economics (they are in favor of regulation of business).
