Child Abuse and Neglect Are Preventable. CDC works to stop child abuse and neglect before they occur. Children's lives are shaped by their experiences, including what happens in their environment (such as homes, schools, and neighborhoods) and the types of relationships they have with parents, teachers, and other caregivers.
